Those members who use the online entry forms to enter regattas are reminded to please check their "sent" box a few minutes after submitting their entry.

In most instances your entry should appear as a sent message if the form was processed successfully. While the Race Secretary should also acknowledge receipt of your entry, it is the responsibility of the entrant to ensure that their details have been included on any online skipper list. If your details do not appear online within 24 hours either;

- 1. Resend the entry by forwarding it from your sent box to the race secretary or**
- 2. Send your name, address and at least three frequencies to the race secretary in a separate plain text email. The subject line should be the regatta you wish to enter.**

While nearly all entries are received without any problems, there is a small percentage that are affected by a configuration glitch which originates at the entrants computer. Online entries are offered as a convenience only and automatic entry should not be assumed by submitting your details online.

If you are unsure that your online entry has been successfully submitted, then cut and paste the below fields into a plain email, complete the details and send as an ordinary email message.

Don't forget the subject line should be the regatta you wish to enter.
