## Ten Rater State NSW Titles – Round 7 10R Series

The weekend of the 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> of November saw the running of the NSW state title for ten raters and round 7 of the NSW GP. Hosted by Koonawarra Bay SC on the shores of Lake Illawarra. This was a much anticipated regatta and culminated a great year for the ten's with fleet numbers slowly rising across the state. Competitors travelled from Foster/Tuncurry in the north, down to Melbourne in VIC. The ACT was well represented; as well as the local Sydney and Central Coast fleet. With an entry list of 26 the fleet was split in two and carefully seeded by Marilyn Russell. Congratulations to the guys who are new to the class; for making a determined effort to enter, and see through a tough regatta. Good numbers in the middle of the fleet are indicative of a healthy class. Much of this is brought about by support from within the ACT and NSW fleets.

Saturday saw the N/East breeze fill early and PRO Jon Pinkerton had racing underway on time, with a long windward return course + bottom gate. Set right in front of the club the course made for good spectator viewing. As the day progressed the high tide released a fair amount of weed from the shore making some of the racing a challenge. Eventually most adapted skills to deal with it and the usual culprits moved into the lead group. With most boats down on "C" rigs, the fleet began to have its share of equipment issues, with some skippers slipping from the front of the fleet at the end of the day. The end of the 1st day's racing saw a consistent Scott Condie with an emerging lead. Garry Bromley sat second after a lot of luck, followed closely by the mexican Andy Reid. Saturday night a large group headed to the local Chinese / Thai restaurant while several skippers headed to repair boat issues.





Overnight a reasonable southerly front swung the wind around and raised the chop to surf able. The course was shifted around the point to allow the start to be sighted. This introduced the rock point to the course and a lot of glare making it difficult at times to spot boats heading the lay line to the top mark.





With many more incidents on the water came plenty of penalty turns and the odd protest. Scott Condie remained consistent to slowly draw away with the lead. Garry Bromley suffered badly from not having a smaller rig, falling back into the fleet and allowing Andy Reid and Phil Page to show their experience in the testing conditions. Of note was Owen Jarvis making a strong return in the placing's after suffering some boat issues. Eventually Scott (17pts) finished first with Andy Reid (41pts) and Phil Page (43pts) chasing hard for second and third place. The event certainly honed the small group heading to WA, with similar conditions expected. Several video's uploaded on You Tube for those interested in ten rater surfing.
