PRO was Frank Russell who set good courses set for the single fleet in light and shifty conditions. Placing's were mixed and racing was always close apart from the times the lead boat picked something up and cleared out on the fleet. This happened more than once.

After race 7 a rain squall came through and by then most skippers had had enough and it was decided to race one more to get two drops. Some elected to take this as a drop and not sail but they missed the best wind of the day.

In the end it came down to consistency. Phil Page was the most consistent with the new Phoenix 6 second was Owen sailing his Phoenix 5.1 from Maurice Fletcher sailing "Genniker" NRW10B which always loves light pond conditions.
