## Saturday



Nineteen skippers arrived bright and early on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> February to race in the second annual regatta in honour of the late Ian Hayden. A light to moderate SE breeze blew all day gradually strengthening to about 8 knots by lunchtime, perfect for 10 Raters with Number 1 rig. Apart from a shower of rain that moved through about 11.45 the conditions were excellent and not too hot. A windward and return course was set using a gate at the bottom. The moon was having large effects on the water level with a rising tide before lunch and a falling tide after lunch. More about this later.

PRO Ted Gay got the ceding races underway just after 10am and kept things moving all day to finish with ten races completed.(20 heats) Marilyn Russell did her usual excellent job taking down the results and doing the scoring, and Rob Fielding drove the rescue boat. Ted asked skippers from the fleet not sailing to be observers, a system that worked really well.



Later in the afternoon the tide was dropping fast and this is where Rob earned his money, or would have if he was actually paid. Many skippers trying to get that little edge came too close to shore and ended running aground. Some not content with doing it once, tried it a second or even a third time and Rob rescued them each time. It all added to the fun, unless of course your boat was the one on the beach and then it wasn't any fun at all.



Marilyn, who keeps a close eye on how everyone is going said that the final placing's were not settled until the last race, so it was very close and exciting.
