

The 2015 NSW 10 Rater State Championship

This year the state championship was hosted by Lake Macquarie Radio Yacht Club at Edwards Park, Booragul. 23 skippers turned up on Saturday morning to do battle. Andrew Reid made the trip from Melbourne and Mark Newman and Steve Sedgmen were there to represent the Canberra MYC. All the NSW 10R clubs were represented by at least one skipper.
