

The lake at present would be suitable for dry launching all classes of yachts except Marbleheads and 10rs. If we get more rain, both these classes would be accommodated as well. Marblehead and 10r skippers would need to walk into the water on a hard clay surface approximately a half metre to launch and retrieve their yachts.

The lake is freshwater and does not have any weed. It is quite deep and is fed by seven other lakes and ponds in the area.

If members inquire, the other good news is that sailors will park next to the lake. Sailors will also have permanent undercover areas with protection from the sun. We will also be able to run two courses at the same time. As discussed previously, WHMBC will cook the bar-b-que lunch and provide drinks for members and their guests (lunch and drinks to be paid for by NSWRYA).

The presentation will take place in the adjacent Workers Hubertus Country Club. The club will be open for guests from 10.30am onwards. Toilets will be open from 9am.
