The Ben Lexcen Trophy has been conducted since the early nineties and is the RC yachting world's celebration of Australia II's win against the yanks in 1983, and a tribute to the design genius who came up with the legendry winged keel. Ben Lexcen (Bob Miller) tried out some of his design ideas using 10 Rater yachts so it's fitting that we have a trophy to commemorate his memory. The trophy was handcrafted by Glen Grenfellow and features a cast aluminium half model of Australia II.
