



The 2018 NSW IOM Interclub Regatta

The IOM Interclub regatta has been held every year since 2004. The idea of an IOM interclub was put together by the then NSW Secretary Daniel Weizman, the Publicity Officer Brad Gibson and the VP Owen Jarvis. Brad donated the perpetual cup we have been competing for every year since. Originally contested between the SMMC, the ECSA and KBRYC it expanded to include any club fielding a team. The points total of the first three boats from each team are added for the club score.

Past winners have been ECSA, SMMC, WMYC, CMYC and KBRYC.

The format is handicap racing but starting with a scratch race so handicaps can be established for the second race. Handicaps are then adjusted after each race. The handicap format gives everyone a chance of a podium finish. (and indeed, every skipper won at least one race) The winning club hosts the regatta the following year.

In 2018 KBRYC hosted the event after having won the cup from Wollongong Model Yacht Club in 2017. Two clubs mounted a challenge, the Lake Macquarie RYC and the Northern Mariners. Unfortunately, WMYC were down a team member and decided to withdraw from the regatta.

Racing got underway just after 10am in a strong gusty WNW breeze that gradually increased and swung to the west and back again all day, not the best direction at Kogarah Bay but there were still 12 races completed on the day. All skippers started with A rig but everyone changed down to B rig after four races. The sailing was challenging in the tricky conditions. Even so everyone had fun.

The Northern Mariners won on a countback from LMRYC and judging by the response of the NM members they will be mounting a very strong defence next year.

Podium finishers were Neil Webb from KBRYC in first place, Paul Jones from LMRYC in second place and Allen Roberts from KBRYC and Wayne Keavy from the NM in equal third place.
