Towards the end of the racing day, the wind strengthened resulting in all competitors except Larry Reedman changing to number 2 rigs. Larry fared badly in this race but the wind moderated for the following race giving Larry an easy win.

The Race Officer for day 2 was Robert Page who implemented a two race then a break schedule for the single fleet. The wind was lighter than day 1 from the south to southeast all day.

The winner was Phillip Page sailing his Italiko with impressive speed to win 22 races out of the 36 races sailed. Second was Scott Condie sailing an Extreme with 8 wins, third with 2 wins, the consistent Owen Jarvis sailing a Triple Crown and fourth, also with 2 wins was Colin Court sailing a Disco.
