



2009 NSWRYA 10 Rater State Championship

The NSWRYA Championship was held over the weekend of the 7th and 8th of November at Kogarah Bay. There were 17 boats ready to start racing at 10 o'clock on Saturday morning. Visitors attempting a raid on the NSW trophy cupboard were Andrew Reid and Pat Parisienne from Victoria, Jeff Byerley from Queensland, and Lynn Kreibig and Stephen Sedgmen from the ACT. The rest of the fleet was filled with sailors from KBRYC, CCRYC, LMRYC, FTRYC and the Northern Mariners.

The PRO for Saturday Scott Condie started racing in a light to moderate easterly breeze which gradually strengthened during the day. At about 11.30am the fleet was split into A and B fleets to make the racing safer in the strengthening breeze. At the end of the first day after 12 races the lead was shared by Jeff Byerley and Andrew Reid with Maurie Fletcher and Chris Stokes close behind.

There were a few sailors didn't make it back on Sunday so the racing was again in one fleet. Sundays PRO Robert Hales started racing in a light SE breeze which gradually swung around to the east and then ENE after lunch. A further 13 races were held on Sunday.

Congratulations to Jeff Byerley (R106) for his win, Andrew Reid (Diamond) for second and Chris Stokes (Phoenix 3) for third. The top three sailed very consistently and well deserved their places. Owen Jarvis (Phoenix 3) and Maurie Fletcher (NRW10B) were only 2 points behind Chris in fourth and fifth place respectively.

It was a great couple of days enjoyed by the sailors and officials. Sailing regattas don't happen without people to run them, so I'm sure all the competitors join me in thanking Scott Condie, Robert Hales, Jim MacGillivray, Colin Court, Karl Peipman, Allan Bicknell, Wayne Keavy, John Haines and scorer Brian Hard.
